## OATS Continued:

- Call 5-7 days in advance for in-town rides
- \$1.50 each way suggested donation
- For people who live outside Columbia, a group comes and leaves together. For these rides, people may go to other places besides medical appointments and grocery stores; such as pharmacies or banks.
- Door to door pick-up and drop-off
- No application process because they are available to the general public
- Children and guests allowed. Children under 18 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- They wait for people for 7-10 minutes at door.

## A-1 Express Taxi and Limos LLC:

(573) 874-7110

- \$1.80 flag (when you first get in the vehicle-starting cost), \$3.50 per mile, \$3 minimum
- Both door to door and curb to curb pick-up and drop-off. It helps to specify when calling.
- For wheelchair user, two guests are allowed for no additional charge. After that, charge is \$1 per guest.
- For non-wheelchair user, \$1 per guest
- They wait 5 minutes, but riders pay wait time after that.

## Missouri Care Transportation:

- Transportation for Missouri Care members to medical appointments
- Members must be deemed medically unable to take public transportation to qualify for private transportation.
- Call at least 3 business days in advance.

## Medicaid Transportation:

(866) 269-5927 (Logisticare)

- Assistance for non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) available if:
  1. You do not have another way to reach your appointment (Para-transit, etc.)
  2. You are eligible for Medicaid or MC+ Fee for Service on the date the transportation is provided under a federal aid category, and
  3. You have a scheduled appointment with a Medicaid enrolled provider for a Medicaid or MC+ covered service.
- You need a letter of medical necessity.
- \$3 co-pay
- If you are enrolled in an MC+ managed care health plan, you should contact the membership services number on your managed care health insurance card. Some managed care health plans will have the phone number for transportation on your card.
- Call for an appointment at least 3 working days before your appointment.
- Have Medicaid ID # and address ready when calling.
